

Before Worship

'A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another' (John 13:34a)

If you were at the 'Alive 175' service last Sunday, you would have seen how love came to life where Lutherans from all over Australia and New Zealand, from Canada from Papua New Guinea worshipped together in unity. The service began as it does every Sunday in worship, by remembering how we have been brought into God's love in the name of the Father, and the Son and the Holy Spirit in our Baptism.

The Son of Man is glorified and God is glorified in him, when sins are forgiven in Jesus name. Love comes to us when the Gospel is read among the congregation, and last Sunday this was enacted in a special way as the Gospel was ceremoniously brought from the altar, to the middle of the congregation and the words of Jesus were read amongst the people by Christ's representative to the Lutheran Church of Australia and New Zealand, President Mike Semmler.

God's love is revealed in Jesus, as we receive his body and blood in Holy Communion in the words Take and eat, This is my body and blood given for you. This is how Jesus is glorified and God is glorified in him. We confess in the creed together, what God has done for us as we tell each other and the world, this is what we believe. At the end of the worship service we are sent out with the blessing, with the assurance God is watching over us as we share God's love in the world, to love others as he has loved us. To be with people in their suffering assuring them that when they feel they can no longer hang onto Jesus, Jesus never lets go of them.

Jesus says 'by this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another, (John 13:35).

Prayer: Lord Jesus, help us to love one another, by having forgiving hearts, by telling them of your love. Amen.
