

Getting There: Self Drive (approx. 688 km), or Bus Travel – The time of bus departure will be 9.00 am on Friday **7 Jun 2013** for arrival at Elliston at about 6.00 pm. Pick up/drop off will be at the Golden Grove Lutheran Church car park at Wynn Vale. Check out of the cabins at Elliston will be 10am on the Monday but we anticipate that the bus will leave at 9.00 am.
