

Dragging someone's good name into the dirt is one of those sins that everyone enjoys at some time or other. It's what makes good headlines in our newspapers and ups the sales to amazing heights. It seems that there is something within us that makes us want to know what the perpetrator has done and how he did it! And it's not just innocent curiosity. Somehow the 'old Pharisee' is there within us reminding us into thinking like the Pharisee of old, "thank you God that I am not like that terrible guy!"

It's not difficult to put another person down but think about the damage it does? James compares it with a bushfire. It only takes a spark to get it going—that's all—but what a consequence! The devil often keeps the full picture from our eyes. He doesn't let us see what damage it does to the other person but **it is absolutely real!** Dragging someone's good name down is a sin. It's like a bushfire that keeps on burning until it finally burns down the house!

Jonathan inspires us to do it differently. When his father, King Saul, out of jealousy wanted to get rid of David, he defended David, spoke well of him and did everything he could to shield him from harm. Instead of agreeing with me when I put someone down, why not defend the other person and be like Christ to him!

#### Family Friendly Worship

We understand that malicious gossip, rumours, innuendoes can hurt but what about when it's all true... and "we only want to be helpful"?

These are some of the questions we shall consider in the address this morning as we look at **the gift of a good name**. We'll be considering how you can destroy a person's name, how do we look after their name and how in fact God has given us a good name.


