Pastor's Column

Do you feel weary/fatigued/worn out?

And that is to be expected if you have been working hard, not looking after your body, under stress.... (Hopefully you know what to do about that.)

But when you realize you are weary from "doing good", then you may need to: Look at *what good* you are doing; *Return* to one who is Good, rest and be renewed in Him; *Keep in mind* the wisdom and promise Paul gives in **Galatians 6: 7-10**, the text we are looking at this morning with the theme "Please don't give up doing good".

At **Salt Factory** this evening I will be continuing the theme of forgiveness with "The 4 promises of forgiveness".

Just what is forgiveness? / What do you mean when you say "I forgive you"? / Do you realize you are making 4 promises every time you forgive someone for something they have done against you?

Please remember that there won't be a salt factory dinner prior to the service (because it is school holidays).

Next Sunday, the theme "we are praying for you" is based on the second reading for the day (Colossian 1:1-14 and in particular verse 9 "For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you. We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives".)

Please note the invitation that Lee Norrey has given to join other women for **Bible Study either Friday or Monday afternoon**.

I fully endorse this and in fact I am so pleased that Lee is leading these that I plan to attend the first few.

How's your Bible reading going? Why not use the "Daily Bible Readings" as your guide. We print them on the back page of the Bulletin each week. I would love the congregation to see this as a major way in which we are united, ie everyone reading the same Bible passages each day, as people meet having a common passage to discuss and every team meeting beginning with a devotion based on the text of the day.

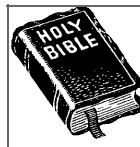
