### Before Worship ....

#### The Devil made me do it!

Finding someone else to blame appears to be the easy way out for many situations people encounter in life, and if there's no-one nearby then the devil gets the blame. Overeating or drinking; irresponsible actions which endanger oneself or others; acting dishonestly and taking the credit away from the one who is truly worthy. Society often appears as having a 'me first, and disregard everyone else' attitude, and this is further exaggerated by both electronic and social media, where a person's popularity or success rises or falls according to how many 'hits' they receives.

Although Adam and Eve didn't have to contend with the barrage of media we experience, they still blamed each other, and when they realised God could see straight through that argument, the snake (the devil in disguise) got the blame. However when God created Adam and Eve he also created their minds, giving them abilities for independent thought and wise decision making. They realised this very quickly and felt the guilt of their actions – and God knew completely what had happened even without really needing to ask, however He also needed them to understand that their actions had consequences – removal from paradise!

God wants to walk with you and share your life, just as He did with Adam and Eve. Are you able to make wise, conscious decisions and NOT get swayed by the crowd, even when following may seem like an easier option? Are you proud of your words and actions, or are you trying to hide something from God? Are you open to God's forgiveness for your life, to be proud of your Christian faith, and to walk confidently with God by your side?

# Pastor's Column

**God invites us to come for a walk with him through the book of Genesis.** And this is what we shall be doing over the next 10 weeks – to have a deeper look at the Book of Genesis - at least the main stories in this book.

This morning we are going to walk with God in the Garden of Eden.

It is apparent that God loved walking in his creation. (**Genesis 3:8** *Then the man and his wife heard the sound of the LORD God as he was walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and they hid from the LORD God among the trees of the garden.*) God enjoyed his creation. He wanted to make the best use of it and he wanted to share that joy with his children so as to enjoy their childlike fascination, discovering life together.

That is the way we are going to walk through this book of Genesis. In this way I believe we God will reveal things to you that may never have occurred to you before and He will enjoy our new discoveries.

However, as you can see from verse 8, Adam and Eve hid themselves from God. They showed that something was wrong. Fear, avoidance... shame had entered the garden- entered Adam and Eve. They had fallen into sin.

We live in that same **fall into sin**.

This morning we are going to consider the trap they fell into and learn from this.

We can learn from this because the devil hasn't changed: his technique hasn't changed and nor has the effects. We need his forgiveness and the assurance that comes from his promise that he will continue to walk with us.

At **Salt Factory** this evening Graham Pfeffer will be preaching on the theme 'Your sins are forgiven'. 'Your faith has saved you. Go in Peace', based on **Luke 7:36-50**. Have you ever felt the deep regret of something you have done? Then you need to hear this address.

**Next Sunday**, we continue Our walk through Genesis, with the story of Cain killing Abel (Genesis 4)

It is **Disability Sunday** for us and Bev Stevenson from Lutheran Disability Services will be speaking during the service.

- Remember this event has been planned to raise money for our new toilets off the Worship Centre.**

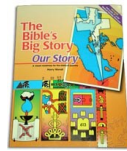
