Before Worship

"Am I my brother's keeper?"

The nerve in Cain's outburst against God is staggering. Yet our nerve is equally staggering, and don't we know it when we slow down to think about it. In seeking to justify ourselves, we ask: What festering disagreement with my fellow member? What selfish act against my God-given spouse, children, parents or friends? What little bit of jealousy over my colleagues' success? What arrogance in my attitude to my Pastor? Am I my brother's keeper?

Thankfully Christ didn't ask his Father the same thing in the Garden. He knew he was our keeper. He knew that in keeping his Father's will he would keep us because we can't keep ourselves. But he also knew it would cost him his blood. But whereas Abel's blood cried out to the Lord for vengeance, Christ's blood cried out for the Father's mercy upon us.

And so to today's Epistle. Because Christ has claimed us and lives hidden in us (Col 3:3), living in us also is his rule over the sin. In this regard the following promise is beyond comprehension: 'When Christ, who is your life, **appears**, then you also will **appear** with him in glory' (Col 3:4). Christ **appears** when you ask in prayer, hear his word, remember your baptism and feast on him at the Lord's table. At these times you are transported into his glory, transformed into a holy and forgiven child of God, free from fear to fear God more than humans, and therefore acknowledge: **"I am my brother's keeper. Let me make it right."**

Most holy and merciful God, Glory be to you as you appear to us in your word in worship today and transport us into your glory. Bless all who worship you here and in your holy Christian churches across your earth this day. Renew us in the knowledge of the image of your Son through whom we are freed to make things right. In Jesus' name. Amen.

Have you thought: "I wonder where that road is going"- A SIDE TRACK!

Do you take side tracks just for the adventure of it? I need to warn you sometimes side tracks can be quite dangerous and often side tracks lead to dead ends, as we shall find out today in our walk through the book of Genesis.

We'll come across some more people Cain and Abel who were affected by their parent's fall and took a side trackwell at least Cain did. Maybe after the fall he couldn't see straight. That's what sin does. It takes our eyes off God.

We'll see how dangerous that track was, the warnings he received and how it actually did turn out to be a dead end.

We'll apply this story to our own lives and see what God is willing to do for us.

Today we are celebrating "**Disability Sunday**". Bev Stevenson from Lutheran Disability Services and Adrian will be speaking during the service.

At Salt Factory this evening James Norrey will give his view on "Pain".
