

Before Worship

Genesis 12:1-7

The amazing thing about the Lord saying to Abram, 'Go from your country, and your kindred, and your father's house to a land that I will show you', is that as revealed in Joshua 24:2, the family didn't even worship God. The Lord called Abram out of idolatry, and promised Abram, "I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing".

Abram though childless at 75 years old believed and trusted the word of God. Now we like to know where we are going before we let someone send us on a journey. This was not a simple pack the gear on the donkey and lets go. No he took Sarai his wife, and Lot his brother's son, and all the possessions that they had acquired in Haran, and they set out. It makes me recall when we came down here from Queensland. We packed all our belongings on a furniture truck, packed the car, and off we went. I took up the call to trust God that he will take us to the faraway land of South Australia and bless and protect us.

Promise and faith work together. The promises of God work faith in those who trust and believe. Through Abram God promised the saviour that would redeem the world and Abram believed and it was credited to him as righteousness. It is the Gospel of our Lord and saviour Jesus Christ we proclaim.

Prayer- Dear Lord, You have placed us on this journey of life. When you call Lord, help us to say, "here I am Lord". Thank you for your word which tells us of the faith of Abram, the faith which believes. Help us to keep believing your word which tells of your saving grace and mercy. In Jesus name. Amen.

Pastor's Column

Do you know much about the spiritual discipline of "Pilgrimage"? It's fascinating.

Pilgrimage is simply to walk with God, trusting in him, often to a sacred place. Actually, the journey is so much more important than the destination. In fact people have gone on a pilgrimage to a sacred site only to bypass it and continue on their pilgrimage......

Pilgrimage is walking with God- in the way he wants us to live - walking in God's promises, just as Abram did (Genesis 12). This was Abram's response to the covenant God was making with him. God was making promises to Abram and Abram was responding with faith

This morning we shall consider these promises to Abram and the promises God makes to us. We'll see how God got Abram's attention and then how Abram followed God: one step at a time, walking away from the past with the knowledge that God chose him. And we'll consider how we too can follow God, based on those promises that he has made to us.

Welcome to Sebastian Pena, family and friends who have come to witness and celebrate **Sebastian's baptism**. Sebastian is of Lisa and Eduardo's son and Heidi and my grandson. The family is now living in Brisbane but have maintained their membership at GGLF.

At **Salt Factory** this evening Andrew Dockerill, a final year ALC student will be speaking on extreme pain. He'll be preaching on the pain that is often manifested in two ways: physical pain, and emotional pain, the cross of Christ: God's ultimate answer to pain. This is a message worthwhile coming a second time to worship to hear.

Next Saturday morning we are holding The Gathering

The theme is "What is the next step on our journey to care/communicate/connect".

It starts at 8.30 am, and should finish about 1pm after a BBQ lunch.

We are holding it again at "Wirrimbirra": Ivan and Elnora Schmocker's, Lot 65 - block at the end of Grenfell Road.

As with previous Gatherings the proceedings start with corporate worship (*bring a chair*), followed by the presentation (*bring a biro*), I will giving a quick overview of where we are and give some suggestions that you can talk about and pray about; morning tea (*bring a plate to share*), quiet time in a tranquil setting (*some people have brought a rug in the past*), group feedback of what God is saying to you and culminating in Holy Communion and a BBQ lunch (*bring a salad and little for a donation towards this*).

I have heard so many good comments about The Gatherings in the past (this is the 6th one). I am sure you will get a lot out of this in fellowship, involvement in the direction of the congregation and your own spiritual development. Come along.
