

### Before Worship ....

#### Genesis 27:

"The story of Jacob deceiving his father Isaac so that he could receive a blessing which was intended for his brother

Lots of times I have acted without thinking about the "what ifs" of my actions.

Then when things go wrong I say to myself "I just didn't think" or "maybe the devil made me do it". I may have falsely believed that's what God wanted me to do.

What about Jacob deceiving his father by pretending to be Esau and receiving God's promise from Isaac? Yes his mother Rebekah's selfish influence motivated him but they had both sinned and undeservedly received reward. There is no doubt in my mind that Jacob's next twenty years plus were full of hard times, sacrifice and disappointment. Perhaps it was part of God's overall promise to Abraham to build a nation of people. Listen to Pastor Leon's message today and make up your own mind.

I keep coming back to the passage in the Bible which says "If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us" (1 John 1: vs 8)

Thoughtless, selfish actions are Satan's playground and I must always be on guard against those impulsive self fulfilling moments that pop up. What about you?

Prayer: Dear Heavenly Father please keep me safe from sin. Show me the way so that I may not deceive myself through thoughtless actions. In Jesus name Amen.

## Pastor's Column

Often in the midst of disasters we hear the question: Where was God in all this? We heard that on 9/11, the Bali bombing, the Japan tsunami.

In the first reading this morning (from **Genesis 27**) we'll hear about Jacob cheating his brother. You can imagine Isaac and Esau in particular asking this question. "Where is God? Why did he let it happen? Why didn't he just step in and stop it. It's such a travesty."

Where is God? He is there in the midst of it all. There walking with each one of them.

This story highlights how real the book of Genesis and the Bible is. It gives an uplifting presentation of God and his grace. But it also brings us down to earth by presenting human nature.... and in dealing with it an even deeper presentation of His grace.

God is walking with each one of us, in whatever we are going through. God is in the mess that is human nature. He was there walking with Rebekah, Isaac, Esau and Jacob and he is walking with us now. That's I what we'll be considering in this morning address.

A special welcome to Cynthia and Margot, the Christian Pastoral Support Workers (for Wynn Vale Primary and Banksia Park Primary, respectively) which we support. Cynthia and Margot will be involved in the service (presenting the readings and the children's address) because it is National Schools Sunday.

Also a **special welcome** to the family and friends of Senior Class Arnold who will be giving part of the presentation they delivered at our Friday worship. It's on the theme of the address this morning- the story of Jacob and Esau.

I shall be taking my **annual leave** from 15<sup>th</sup> September to 12<sup>th</sup> October. (So this is the last time I shall be leading worship till 13<sup>th</sup> October).

For pastoral emergencies see one of our pastoral carers, your fellowship group or one of our neighbouring pastors.

Thanks to Graham Pfeffer, Pastor Peter Hartwich, Matt Bishop and Pastor Len for leading the morning worship in my absence.

Cast your fishing line from the Jetty, Marina or North Beach Suggested Bait: Cockles, Worms, Gents, Pilchards, Squid

The Wallaroo Jetty extends out for 869 metres into water that is up to 10 metres deep. Amongst the types of fish anglers may catch are snapper, squid, flathead, tommy ruff, garfish, snook, salmon and mullet. Weigh In at 5:30 pm.
