

Date: Saturday 21st September 2013 Time: 11.30am Where: Meet at the Wallaroo Jetty Car F

Where: **Meet at the Wallaroo Jetty Car Park** (allow 1.75-2.00 hours driving).

Cast your fishing line from the Jetty, Marina or North Beach

Suggested Bait: Cockles, Worms, Gents, Pilchards, Squid

The Wallaroo Jetty extends out for 869 metres into water that is up to 10 metres deep. Amongst the types of fish anglers may catch are snapper, squid, flathead, tommy ruff, garfish, snook, salmon and mullet. Weigh In at 5:30 pm.
