### Before Worship ....

#### Would you 'Listen to one back from the dead'? (Luke 16:31)

As a parent, what we say or do can come back at us through our children. They pick up on our words, actions and behaviours much more than we realise. Even at work or school, those seemingly unimportant actions can have an impact on a colleague, student or client that we may never think about.

Our reading from today show us some of the implications of people's greedy actions, and while in the moment there may have been little consequence – in the long term these actions influenced life outcomes:

- Life and death: Joseph recognised his brothers and forgave them, providing them with food, shelter and a new life. (even though he had some 'fun' with them along the way) Had they REALLY changed? Was there any remorse in their hearts? Genesis 42 & 45
- Accumulating money and other riches for your own prestige. Placing these ahead of God, and losing faith along the way. Remember we come into the world with nothing – AND leave with nothing. 1 Timothy 6
- Looking out for others along the way. God provides us with all that we need – and more! Do we share it with others who DO NOT have such a provision? Luke 16

Father God, remind us each day that our actions (and inactions) reflect our love for you. Help us to know that what may seem a small and insignificant act of generosity can bring eternal rewards.
