

Before Worship

The temptation when we hear texts such as today's Gospel from Luke is that we despair we don't have enough faith. Jesus says in Luke:

"If you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it will obey you...

That seems nigh on impossible. Who'd grow a mulberry tree in the in the sea anyway? Well, relax because it's not all about you - at least, in so far as where your faith comes from and the sorts of things God will direct you to do in it! The reading from Paul's second letter to Timothy reminds us that faith is gift from God and it works for His purpose:

'... fan into flame the **gift** of God... for the Spirit God **gave** us does not make us timid, but **gives** us power, love and self-discipline'.

So it's great you are here today. By being here your faith muscle will grow with his **gift** of power, love and selfdiscipline. In part it comforts and preserves us in those difficult 'Lamentations' times of life that our Old Testament lesson reminds us of today. But it also achieves whatever mulberry tree uprooting and planting in the sea that God gives us to do.

The blessing of Almighty God - the Father, Son and Holy Spirit - be with you as you open His gift of faith in our church services today.

Prayer: Heavenly Father, thank you that you give us faith. Prepare my heart, mind and soul for your gift of faith today. Bless Pastor Len and everyone else who serves in your Service of us today. In Jesus' name. Amen.


