

Before Worship

"Will God not judge in favour of His own people who cry to Him day and night for help I tell you, He will judge in their favour and do it quickly." Luke 18:7-8

In Luke 11:5ff Jesus tells us to be persistent in our praying when an answer doesn't come as quickly as we think it should. Have you ever felt like that? I certainly have! It's then quite easy to give up praying altogether because, being the kind of people that we are, we want our prayers answered straight away. It's like saying to God: "God we have tried doing it your way but it doesn't work. You haven't delivered!" And so a little hurt and perhaps disillusioned, we let go of His promises and we struggle on in life without Him—that's letting go of God!

Is it really true that God is slow in answering our prayers or that at times He ignores them altogether? No. A very definite NO! God loves us far too much for that to happen. Should such a thought ever come to you then take another look at the One on the cross where His promises receive all their power. He will judge in favour of His own people and **He will do it quickly.** Not like a machine that responds to a coin being put in a slot where there is an immediate result—but when the right time for Him and us has come. He will answer and He will answer quickly—because He says so.

It's like this: "Ask and it shall be given to you; seek and you shall find; knock and it shall be opened to you".

Prayer: Lord Jesus, increase my faith in You so that I never doubt Your power in my life and the lives of others. Amen.

Family Friendly Worship

At Golden Grove, we love **everybody** to be involved in worship.

Please encourage children and visitors to join in the singing and prayers, and to stand and sit at appropriate times when they are able. This is best done by leading by example!

For our 'little ones' - Quiet bags & busy books are available for worship time from the children's area inside the church.

The "Kids at Heart" team run a QUIET craft table during the sermon. That way, the children have some time with their parents during the morning services, and also a little bit of time to be creative, to wriggle around and to learn about our God and what He means to us through artistic activities, with their friends. All children are welcome to join in this time. It is not appropriate for unattended children to play in the foyer at any time during the service. Please ask an usher if you require assistance, or speak to a "Ministry Leader" if you would like to help young families during worship times.

Pastor's Column

Now that I am saved/ a Christian/ know that God loves me/ assured of eternal life- what now? How am I to live my life? **What now?**

We know that we are to be different to those who are not yet saved- we are to be "salt and light in the world" - but just what does that look like?

The Bible tells us to be *persistent*. But just what does this persistence look like?

Don't we learn from example? We look to people. As children we look at our parents; as we grow up, to our peers and role models. As Christians, aren't there people we look to, look at/ look up to- to show us how to live? I am thinking of people in leadership and those we admire.

This is where the Church has determined that *saints* have a role. Not to pray to or through whom we can expect a miracle. No, a saint is someone God has filled with his Holy Spirit and has set him or her apart (*made them holy*) so that they can be an example, a model for us- to show us the way God wants us to live.

One such person is **Saint Mary MacKillop**: Australia's first saint according to the Roman Catholic tradition.

This morning I would like to concentrate on one trait that God gave her and used in her life. The one that is brought up in our Bible readings this morning: *persistence*.

I pray that she may be an inspiration for you, that God through her example may encourage you to be more persistent, and that you can thank God for the life of Mary MacKillop and all that she did to God's glory.

This is a good message in regard to our giving. Next Sunday is our **Thanksgiving Sunday** when we are encouraged to give beyond our weekly "tithe"- as an expression of thanks to god, for the work of our congregation. Remember the challenge that Lauren Thiel announced last Sunday: an anonymous donor is prepared to match every dollar over \$5000 to an amount of \$5000!

These days **The Journey 2013** course (confirmation lessons) are coming to an end. Next weekend the guys on the Journey are going on a camp to consider "faith in the world" (the Ten Commandments) which will lead to many of them being confirmed; a couple on 10th November and the rest on 17th.

Korean Christian Community Church will (God willing) begin on 10th November, 11.30am here at Golden Grove Lutheran Fellowship. One of our members David Shin will be leading this. Our vision is that these services will become fortnightly and that members of this community will be integrated into our Fellowship. Please see me for more details.

I strongly encourage you to get involved in our **Christmas program** in any way you can. Margey Knapp has written this brilliant play we'll be using and Margot Mertin has agreed to direct it. It will be child friendly and I believe evangelism tool and a wonderful way to get involved in the life of the congregation.


