### Before Worship ....

Haggai 1: vs7/9

"And I will fill this house with glory and in this place I will grant peace" declares the Lord Almighty.

Haggai was a prophet in Jerusalem during 520B.C. He encouraged the returned Jewish exiles to obey the Lord and rebuild Solomon's Temple, albeit it took about two years before they got started.

He preached the consequences of disobedience and the blessings of obedience. When the people give priority to God and his house they are blessed.

Obedience brings the encouragement and strength of the Spirit of God.

In verse 4 the Lord encouraged the people "Be strong, all you people of the land, for I am with you. My Spirit remains among you. Do not fear."

Some 500 years later Paul wrote to the Thessalonians reminding them that God is with them always and that the second coming of Jesus Christ will happen when we least expect it ("like a thief in the night" he wrote).

"Until then stand firm and hold to the teachings we passed on to you, whether by word of mouth or by letter" (2Thessalonians vs 15)

As Paul wrote," I pray that you, Our Father who loves us and by your Grace gives us eternal encouragement and good hope, encourage our hearts and strengthen us in every good deed and word" In Jesus name we pray. Amen.

### Pastor's Column

Welcome to Elijah and Lauren's family and friends who have come for their **confirmation** this morning. (The rest of the class (who have taken The Journey of faith 2013- our confirmation course) will be (God willing) confirmed next Sunday and most (if not all of them) again in the morning service.

I pray that you will encourage them as they are an encouragement to us (by confessing their faith, especially through their "I believe" statements) and as God encourages them (confirms/strengthen/blesses) in the service this morning.

Elijah and Lauren will be presenting their "I believe" statements in this morning service. (The "I believe" statements of the whole class (17 in all) will be printed in a booklet which will be available next Sunday.) Remember their "I believe" statement is an expression of where they are on their journey of faith at the moment and for many is a deeply personal witness.

The saint we are bringing alive this week - showing how relevant they are to us today - is **Florence Nightingale**. Not literally a saint as some people understand saints, yet someone God has given gifts- in her case: compassion and mercy- wonderful gifts that God encourages in us.

As I shall say to the confirmees in the address today: "Being alive in Christ is simply relying on him, knowing his grace through the Bible, responding to that grace in prayer, with and within the community and in the world God has placed you/ the life God is giving you." It's this life that allows the gifts God has planted in us to grow. May what God did in and through Florence Nightingale be an extra encouragement for us.

Today is a red letter day for another reason.

Yes it's Martin Luther's birthday (he is 526 by my calculations) but even more important- we begin our **Korean Community Christian Church** (God willing) here at Golden Grove Lutheran Fellowship.

One of our members David Shin will be leading this. Our vision is that these services will become fortnightly and even weekly and that members of this community will be integrated into our Fellowship. Please see me for more details.
