## Before Worship ....

In the reading this morning (Matthew 24:36-44) Jesus warns us that the end of this world will come when we are least expecting it, "therefore keep watch" (verse 42). Another way of saying that is Have Hope: know that whatever you are going through, God is still in control, he has plans for us, he will look after us.

How do we take hold of this hope? Keep close to God, through Jesus in the power of the Holy Spirit. He wants to talk to you this morning— listen to him, he wants you to talk to him each day- use Advent to regularly read his Word, he wants to give himself to you in Holy Communion— take up his offer this evening (at Salt Factory) and next Sunday morning.

Have hope. The candle (of hope) reminds us of this gift from God.

Prayer. Father, thank you for the hope we have in you. Fill us with this hope again this morning. Protect us from all that would steal this hope from us, in Jesus' name. Amen.

# Pastor's Column

**Welcome to our church school picnic today** ("*GGLPS/GGLF annual family day*"). I hope you have a really great day: using this opportunity to catch up with people, enjoy the activities, the food and drink supplied and just relax in this wonderful setting.

This morning's service centres on the first candle (as we count up to Christmas – we call that *"Advent"*.) This candle is called **hope**.

Candles teach us a lot about hope, as we'll discover in the message this morning. So just what is hope? It has something to do with waiting. But it's more than just

waiting. It is a waiting that strengthens our trust, gives us joy and allows us to serve and, all of this comes from God himself.

I love the Bible verse **Romans 15:13** *May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.* 

As you can see in the printed order of service for this morning's service this Bible verse serves as our blessing today.

May you have hope- not only today or as we prepare for Christmas - but in whatever situation you are facing.

Remember you can talk to me or one of the Pastoral Carers if you feel you are in a hopeless situation.
