TWO MINUTES BEFORE WORSHIP...

"As Jesus walked beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. "Come follow me" Jesus said "and I will send you out to fish for people". Mark 1: Vs 16, 17

If someone came up to you when you are at work and invited you to drop everything and come with him or her, what do you think your immediate reaction would be?

Mine would be "Why should I?"

However, if I knew the person and I am not sure that Simon and Andrew knew Jesus that well, maybe I would consider the invitation.

The person inviting me would have to have a lot of charisma and my confidence in him or her plus some common goals that I believed in for me to even move from my work position.

I would need to see leadership, establish mutual trust, see what I believed the benefits were likely to be and have confidence in my own ability to be able to follow the leader and meet his or her expectations. For me that might take a little more time than what Simon and Andrew and subsequently James and John took. They just downed tools and followed Jesus.

Praise the Lord that they did. God knew they would and he knows what we would do too.

Dear Heavenly Father thank you for your faith in us to follow your commandments and seek your presence. Guide us, teach us and talk to us through your Word as we talk with each other and as we seek to fish for people to your glory.
