

TWO MINUTES before Worship

Expressions of faith.

All creatures look to you to give them their food at the proper time. When you give it to them, they gather it up; when you open your hand, they are satisfied with good things. (Psalm 104: 27, 28)

One expression of faith on this harvest thanksgiving festival is simply to have the groceries before us on display, on and around the stage (in the Sanctuary as we call it in ecclesiological terminology).

How is this an expression of faith? We are saying it all comes from God. Yes, through the shops, from the ground, through hard work and over time but nevertheless from God (who gives rain, the seed, the strength, the markets etc.) He gives it to us.

Another expression of faith is this Bible verses, which you may recognize as part of a traditional table grace (above it's in the TNIV) and is part of the responsive readings today.

How is *this* an expression of faith? We are declaring that God gives the "food at the proper time". How can we say that when creatures (including human beings and fellow Christians at that) perish from starvation?

This can open up a whole range of issues such as politics and the unfair distribution of the world's resources, our lifestyle and simple living as well as our response of faith and generosity, namely to gather it up- receive it in thanks and give to those in need. This is a stimulating small group discussion topic. (Saying this may remind us that next Sunday is "Small Groups Sunday".)

The second part of the above verses – about God's open hand are in themselves a deeper expression of faith.

We are declaring that God's open hand is a hand of blessing, healing, comfort and not open to slap us. It's a declaration that God is good in all that he does and all who he is.

So, we join the Psalmist in giving thanks to the Lord, with the declaration that he is good and that his love endures forever. (Psalm 107:1)

No matter what we see or experience we know that he is good because he gave Jesus to die for us to give us the close relationship we have with him by faith.

Prayer: Father, thankyou for the faith we have to declare that you are good. Thankyou for the harvest before us and assurance that you are always looking after your creation. Thankyou that we have the opportunity to express our thanks in worship this morning. Amen. Pastor Leon

Pastor's Column

Give thanks to the Lord for he is good for his mercy endures forever! (Psalm 107:1) What a beautiful new banner we have in our sanctuary! Give thanks....Why aren't we more thankful? A good question to ask on this our **Harvest Thanksgiving.** One reason is because we are not looking *in the right direction.* Let's go with the ten lepers whom Jesus healed as they made their way to the priest (as told in the Gospel reading this morning) and consider how we can have the eyes of the leper who praised God and gave thanks to Jesus.

You have opportunity today to give thanks in our singing and prayers and through our physical gifts of perishable items to Australian Lutheran College (married student families), non-perishable to Lutheran Community Care and donations to Australian Lutheran World Service.

What a wonderful day to say thanks for Talei Corpus and for our gift of baptism with **Talei's baptism** today.

Another name for **Holy Communion** is Eucharist- a thanksgiving meal. How appropriate it is to have Holy Communion at our Harvest thanksgiving service. Another reason we have altered our routine is that the service next Sunday, our Small Groups Ministry Sunday doesn't really accommodate Holy Communion.

In regard to next Sunday, **Small Groups Ministry Sunday**, as we have said in the past, it's for those in Fellowship Groups, those who are looking for something a Fellowship Group might be able to provide as well as those who really thought about Fellowship Groups.

Salt Factory is on tonight! Come along to the dinner prior to the service (5.45pm) for a casual meal and a time of fellowship.

Yesterday our confirmees had their "**Day Camp**" which they used to prepare for the day of **Confirmation** on 19th February.

We start **a new Journey course** in March and in preparation for this course we are holding a meeting of prospective confirmees (year 7 and above) and their parents on Monday 27th February. (See flyers in the foyer)

Talking about new course Step up to Communion (a 6 week course on Sunday afternoons) starts on February $19^{\rm th}$ (See flyers in the foyer)

Ash Wednesday is on 22nd February. Our theme for this year's Lent (which will be featured on the Sundays in Lent is "*Journey to the cross*". We'll be having a closer look at Gospel of Mark account of Jesus' journey to the cross and our journey through life. During Lent you are invited to join the "The Gift that Lasts" (*Bibles for persecuted Christians*)- a program of the Bible League.

One more **advance notice**: **4**th **March** our worship will feature a presentation of where we are at with **our partnership with Asaroka**. Another advance Notice: **1**st **April 6.30pm**: School Family Service (year 4/5 cluster) and Admission to Holy Communion (First Communion)
