TWO MINUTES before Worship

"For the God who said "out of darkness the light shall shine" is the same God who made **his** light shine in our hearts to bring **us** the knowledge of God's glory shining in the face of **Christ**". **2** Corinthians **4** ; vs **6**

In *Mark 9: vs 2 - 9* we read of the "*Transfiguration of Jesus*" being witnessed by Peter, James and John high on the mountain. Elijah and Moses were present. The three disciples were overawed at their mountain top experience especially when they saw Jesus' clothes shining whiter than anyone in the world could wash them. Then God spoke to them.

I think Jesus took Peter, James and John up the mountain for two reasons.

To have support (we all need that) and for them to witness God's revelation of his beloved son. Strangely, Jesus commanded them not to tell anyone about their experience until the Son of Man had risen from death.

I believe Jesus is the "light" that leads us when the dark clouds loom in our lives and shows us the way, often without us realizing it. A sort of serendipity "what happened" Whatever it was it was a good feeling. Not unlike when we stand at the top of a mountain and survey the wondrous scene.

Do you feel closer to God? .Do you feel better for the experience? I do.

Pastor's Column

Welcome to our **Confirmation Service**, **Shannon's Baptism** and where two of the confirmees will be "**Stepping Up to Communion**". As part of the confirmation service all of the young people who are being confirmed will be reading out their "**I Believe Statements**" (which are available in the foyer this morning).

Since this worship has so much in it we have cut the liturgy to the bare minimum which also means a very short address.

11 young people have completed the Journey course and are being confirmed today: Joel Schiller, Dahlia Klunyk, Jessica McLuckie, Sarah Dutschke, Austin Neale, Noah Hahn, Chloe Davidson, Chelsea Beckett, Rebekah Pfeffer, Celina Heuston and Shannon McGill (in order of baptism/confirmation).

We start **a new Journey course** in March and in preparation for this course we are holding a meeting of prospective confirmees (year 7 and above) and their parents on Monday 27th February. *(See flyers in the foyer)*

Talking about new courses... **Step up to Communion** (a 6 week course on Sunday afternoons that leads to being received as a communing member of our congregation) begins this afternoon. **(See flyers in the foyer)**

Welcome to **Pastor Greg Fowler** who will be leading the service this evening at **Salt Factory.** We plan to have a special time of prayer in that evening service to acknowledge the hurt and suffering people have endured as a result of past events. It will be an opportunity to show our love and support as they heal and work through painful issues.

We shall be installing Jason Kupke as our Youth Worker at Salt Factory today, and introducing and praying for him during the morning service as well.

Wasn't the **Small Group Ministry worship** last Sunday morning inspiring? I hope that Pastor Steen Olsen's presentation not only refreshes our Fellowship Group ministry but also encourages those of us who don't belong to a fellowship group to join one.

Lent starts this coming week with **Ash Wednesday** and our worship will be held in the Prayer Garden. The theme is "In Simon the leper's home" – the first in our series for the Sundays in Lent of "*Journey to the cross*" (based on Mark's account of Jesus' journey to the cross and our journey through life.) After each address a **Fellowship Group/ Personal Discussion Guide** will be available to further explore what the message means for your life.

If you would like to attend **mid week Lenten service**s, you are encouraged to attend **St John's Dernancourt** each Wednesday in Lent at 7.30pm (the service goes for about 45 minutes). The theme is: **"The Responses to Christ in Mark's passion account**: the woman anoints Jesus, Judas' betrayal, High Priest response, Crowd's reaction, the Officer's confession.

The theme for **next Sunday's worship** is "In the upper room" (Mark 14:17-31)

Today you are invited to pick up the devotional booklet **"The Gift that Lasts"** with reports from countries where Christians are being persecuted for their faith and the Bible shaped money box. This is part of our *Bibles for persecuted Christians program* which has been supplied to us by the Bible League. This program which starts next Sunday will run for 3 weeks.

In a couple of week's time our worship will feature a presentation of where we are at with **our partnership with Asaroka.**




We will be following the theme of Pastor's message where possible, and using the resources of "Come and See Jesus" curriculum.
