TWO MINUTES before Worship

Mark 1:10-11 As soon as Jesus came up out of the water, he saw heaven opening and the Spirit coming down on him like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, "You are my own dear Son. I am pleased with you."


Here, at Jesus' baptism, we are given a clear recording of the presence of the Triune God. In these verses Mark describes Jesus the Son being baptised in the Jordan River and as Jesus rises up out of the water, we witness the Spirit alighting on Jesus 'like a dove' and God the Father declaring "Here's my boy. I'm mighty proud of you!"

It was a momentous occasion. Jesus' ministry was beginning and God was declaring that Jesus was the Messiah the Jews were waiting for. At another momentous occasion, the transfiguration (see Mark 9), the Father spoke similar words of affirmation, "This is my own dear Son - listen to Him!" God the Father wants us to be his sons too. Jesus died to make sure that we receive the Father's inheritance. And the Spirit works in our lives giving us faith and hope.

Dear Father in Heaven, you created us and love us. We thank you for sending your own dear Son to ensure that we can live with you, as your sons, forever. In Jesus name we pray, Amen.

Pastor's Column

Today we continue our Journey to the Cross with "In the upper room" (Mark 14:17-31)....We encounter a very tense moment – in the upper room - when a certain announcement is made. I wonder whether you have ever been at a meal when you have been floored by a strong announcement. You are invited to use the **Fellowship Group/ Personal Discussion Guide** which is available in the foyer (with copies of the sermon) to further explore what the message means for your life.

We welcome the Hancock's this morning for the celebration of Seth's baptism. What a wonderful gift God gives us through such a simple means as Baptism. This is something we can truly celebrate as His family.

This morning we are launching the 3 week program "**The Gift that Lasts**" *Bibles for persecuted Christians* (a devotional resource with reports from countries where Christians are being persecuted for their faith and the Bible shaped money box.) I hope you enjoyed the DVD we showed before worship on this. *See elsewhere in this Bulletin for more details.*

If you would like to attend **mid week Lenten services**, you are encouraged to attend **St John's Dernancourt** each Wednesday in Lent at 7.30pm (the service goes for about 45 minutes). The theme is: **"The Responses to Christ in Mark's passion account**: the woman anoints Jesus, Judas' betrayal, High Priest response, Crowd's reaction, the Officer's confession.

The small (prayer) chapel is now available again: reconsecrated, restored and ready for prayer! I encourage you to use it.

At Salt Factory tonight I shall be speaking about **The Sacred Journey**: a spiritual discipline called "the pilgrimage". I find this a fascinating means to come closer to God. Come along to consider whether you could use this spiritual discipline yourself. To consider spiritual disciplines is most relevant as we start this season of Lent.

Don't forget about our meeting of prospective confirmees (year 7 and above) and their parents TOMORROW NIGHT in preparation for the **new Journey course** that I am planning to start in March **(See flyers in the foyer)**

Next Sunday morning the theme for the service is "Deep in the garden" (Mark 14:321-42). That service will feature a presentation of where we are at with our partnership with Asaroka.

Welcome to everyone, especially the children! The Kids at Heart activities team are now well into the swing of

things and have a roster for the Children's activities (see in church foyer).

There will be some changes to the children's program this year.

In the foyer, we will continue to run a Children's quiet craft activity during the Pastor's message. This commences immediately after the Children's address. This area, as a Children's space, appears to be working out nicely for everyone.

In addition to the craft activity, on non-communion Sundays, i.e. 1st, 3rd and possibly the 5th Sunday of the month, we will have an extended "Kids at Heart time" until the end of the service.
