TWO MINUTES before Worship

Acts 4:32-35

It is beautiful to think of all believers being one in heart and mind, like it says in this passage. It is so easy for us to focus on our differences rather than building on what we have in common. It says in scripture that we are one body and that each part is as important as the other. If we stick together and work together with Christ as the head, what is there that we can't achieve for God?

This passage talks about how the early Christians would sell their farms and place all the money at the disciples' feet. This was their source of income and food for them and the generations to come. And guess what, they sacrificed this for Christ and His church. Now I don't believe God is calling us to sell our homes, but I do think he wants us to make sacrifices for him. If we look at the idea of tithing, we see that it is 10% of our earnings. I'm sure we all have this down pat already, so let me challenge you with a new idea. How about giving God 10% of our time. Let's assume most people are awake for 16 hours a day, that's 1.5 hours which is "God's time". Is God worth 10% of our time and what we have?

Pastor's Column

At a recent Pastoral Carers meeting we spoke about our role as Pastors Carers. One expression that caught my attention was: "A tap on the shoulder". I felt that described precisely what our role is and for that matter how Christ works in our life too- which is not surprising because that is all the GGLF Pastoral Carers want to be: People through which Christ works: Christ's hands- encouraging us to be His hands in our community.

Today we're going to consider how Christ gave "a tap on the shoulder" on that first Easter evening, as recorded in today's Gospel reading and how he taps us on the shoulder these days.

This evening in **Salt Factory** I shall continue this theme of "a tap on the shoulder" by relating how God tapped me on the shoulder when he called me to be a pastor. I don't think I have ever related this story to our congregation. It may get us thinking about how God taps us on the shoulder or putting it another way calls us into something.

This morning we shall bless our newest Pastoral Carer: **Lyn Plane**. She joins the other 9 **Pastoral Carers:** Ken Campbell, Christiaan Hersevoort, Elnora Schmocker, Marty Seidel, Liz & Dave Shrowder, Claire & Len Tscharke and Judith Whaites. We thank God for the encouragement he gives through our Pastoral Carers.

Lyn Plane under my direction has coordinated the formation of a new small group in our congregation: **Women's Fellowship.** We meet on the second Wednesday of each month from 1 till 2.30pm in the Fellowship Lounge.

At the first meeting last week we spoke about how Women's Fellowship could include talking about God in our lives, ways in which we could serve and social events between these meeting times.

I will preach on the theme each week for the 20 weeks of the Challenge. We'll read through the Old Testament from 6/5/12- 13/7/12 and we plan to start the New Testament in September.

From this Sunday, 15 April at 6.30pm, Compass on the ABC will screen the eight-part Australian series, Hospital Chaplains: It's a Tough Job.

It was filmed in the greater Sydney

area with Catholic and Protestant, Muslim, Jewish and Buddhist chaplains and pastoral carers at Royal North Shore, St. Vincent, and Liverpool hospitals. "Regardless of their faith, they all meet the same challenges - to help make sense of the mystery of illness, pain, suffering and despair". Shot over six months at three major Australian hospitals, this series offers a unique and neverbefore-seen perspective on the daily life and death drama of Australian hospital chaplains. Judith Dunbar coordinates pastoral care and is a supervisor in CPE at Royal North Shore and shared that the film crew told her they had absolutely no idea of the breadth and depth of what chaplains and pastoral carers get into in our public hospitals, that this was one of the most exciting projects they have been engaged in for a long time and they think it will be a real eye-opener for most Australians. Clinical Pastoral Education will be highlighted as a significant component demonstrating how people get training for doing chaplaincy and pastoral care.
