

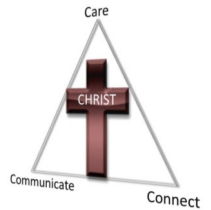

### TWO MINUTES before Worship ....

#### 1 John 3

*<sup>1</sup> See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him. <sup>2</sup> Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know that when Christ appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is. <sup>3</sup> All who have this hope in him purify themselves, just as he is pure.*

It is because of his great love for us that God sent his one and only Son to die so we might be set free from sin. **Companion Books and Reading Planners again on sale today.**

## From the LCA President

MARRIAGE AMENDMENT BILL 2012 & MARRIAGE EQUALITY AMENDMENT BILL 2012

We are blessed to live in our countries of New Zealand and Australia and while this matter is before the Australian Federal Government, New Zealand offers the same opportunities as that afforded to our Church in this instance.

You will be aware we have made representation to Parliamentarians; we have joined other Churches in a statement; we have made our own presentation to 'Marriage Bills Public Hearing' and that statement is available on the website (<http://www.lca.org.au/lca-says-no-to-same-sex-marriage.html>) to which was appended an opinion from the Chair of CSBQ who has made representation from his medical point of view as well. Given this, it was a privilege to be invited as a 'witness' to speak to the House of Representatives Standing Committee on Social Policy and Legal Affairs when they met in Sydney on 12 April.

Not every country in the world has that privilege and responsibility offered to a variety of groups including Churches.

It is important to us that the created order of marriage where the unique relationship of husband and wife illustrated by Christ giving himself to the Church to enable the Church to exist, has its integrity and uniqueness as the institution without which society cannot even exist, preserved.

Keep thanking God for our good governments, regardless of the outcome of this issue for Australia which may well be judged on 'human rights' and the 'evolution of society', both of which are limited by the human judgement of what is good and what is not.
