E100 Bible reading challenge

Week 1— In the beginning

Overview

In this week's readings we discover that the Bible makes no attempt to prove the existence of God but just simply says God was in the beginning. God created humankind and gave them life and a mandate. Sin (disobeying God) subverted what God had planned. To rid the world of sin, God destroyed all life on earth. However, God found one man, Noah, who was righteous and told him to build an ark to save his family from the flood. Sadly it was not long after the flood before sin again took effect. In an attempt to prove they could be as mighty as God, people began building a tower which was later destroyed by God. God confused the people's language so they would be unable to communicate with each other, causing people to migrate throughout the earth.
