

E100 Bible reading challenge

Week 2— Abraham, Isaac & Jacob

Overview

In this week's readings we discover that Abram (later changed by God to Abraham) was chosen to have a special relationship with God. God promised Abraham that he would have a son and that he would become the father of many descendants. As Abraham and his wife grew older without any children, they decided to take matters into their own hands and have a child through a servant, Hagar. In spite of this, God reaffirmed his promise to Abraham and a second son, Isaac, was born to him and his wife Sarah. Later, the Lord asked Abraham to sacrifice Isaac. Whilst preparing to obey, Isaac asked Abraham a question, to which he responded, "God himself will provide the sacrifice". The promise God gave to Abraham passed on to Isaac and Isaac's son, Jacob—a promise the Lord Jesus Christ later made to all who would follow him.


