E100 Bible reading challenge

Week 3— **The Story of Joseph**

#### Overview

This week's readings focus primarily on Joseph, the son of Jacob, who received a dream from God. When he told it to his brothers they became so angry that they agreed to sell him into slavery. Joseph ended up in Egypt, where his master's wife made advances towards him. Joseph resisted and was imprisoned when she made false accusations against him. He continued to be faithful to God and was given the ability to interpret dreams; this eventually led to his release from prison and promotion to the highest position under Pharaoh. A famine forced Joseph's brothers to travel to Egypt to buy grain from Joseph, whom they did not recognize. His family was finally reconciled and reunited when he revealed his identity to them. Joseph declared to his family that God had been working out his purposes all along.

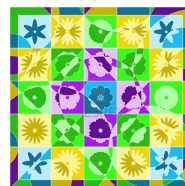
Fun, Interactive music sessions for pre-school children.
