E100 Bible reading challenge

Week 4— **Moses and the Exodus**

Overview

In the course of this week's readings we have been introduced to Moses, one of the most significant characters of the Old Testament. Moses grew up as a member of Pharaoh's family, but was forced to flee Egypt when he committed murder as an act of revenge for the way the Israelites were being treated by the Egyptians. Years later, the Lord appeared to him in the form of a burning bush and commanded him to go back to Pharaoh and demand that he set the Israelites free. In this week's study, we will take a deeper look at the manner in which God called Moses to that significant task.

This morning I am going to put to you from the Bible passage that God's **uses the unexpected** and **His Word to deepen our trust** in Him. That's His way. - ◆ At GGLF the Old Testament Challenge goes until 8/7/12 (and we plan to start the New Testament in September).

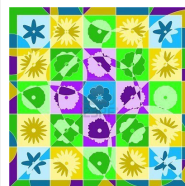
