Week 5— **The Law and the Land**

Overview

The people of Israel left Egypt and continued to be guided by God. When they reached Mount Sinai, God spoke to them and set them apart to be his special people; a kingdom of priests and a holy nation. God also gave them the Ten Commandments to shape the way they worshipped God and related to one another. This would set them apart from other nations. But the people of Israel wavered in their obedience to God's way and so spent forty years wandering in the wilderness. Once they reached the border of the Promised Land, God allowed Moses to see it, but not to lead the people in taking possession of it. It was Moses' successor Joshua who would lead Israel into the Promised Land.

- ◆ A plan to help us develop a regular habit of spending time with God through prayer and Bible reading.
- ◆ 100 carefully selected readings designed to give us a good understanding of the Bible story.
- ◆ Bible readings listed on the back of each Bulletin.
- ◆ 10 minutes each day (5 days a week) set aside to read
- ◆ The "Companion" (devotional) book is available when ordered for extra insights, (an *app* is available too).
- ◆ The "Reading Planner" with a "punch out card" has the whole set of readings clearly set out. It reminds us to: "pray, read, reflect, apply and pray" as well as giving you some helps for the Challenge. (Available free of charge from the stage.)
- ◆ At GGLF the Old Testament Challenge goes until 8/7/12 (and we plan to start the New Testament in September).
- ◆ With the possibility of joining the Challenge any time.
