Week 6— **The Judges**

Overview

The book of Judges describes a period in Israel's history that was marked by unfaithfulness, disobedience and defeat. Instead of seeking the Lord, they did what was right in their own eyes. Yet in the course of the book of Judges we meet some amazing individuals: Deborah, a female judge who courageously obeyed God in a male dominated society and set an example of courage in the midst of adversity; Gideon, the somewhat reluctant leader who obeyed God when he was assured that God was with him; Samson, who was born to godly parents but whose life ended in disaster because he was unable to look past the beauty of Philistine women; and Ruth, whose story is one of the greatest love stories of all time.
