E100 Bible reading challenge

Week 8— The Fall of Israel

Overview

In this week's readings we have seen that David, a man after God's heart, was not above falling into temptation. David committed adultery and murder with tragic consequences not only for himself but his family and nation. His son Solomon asked God for wisdom, saw the glory of God and yet fell into idolatry. From the glorious days of David and Solomon, Israel fell into the depths of defeat under successive kings. Through the prophet Elijah, God clearly demonstrated that he is the one true God. But even Elijah himself succumbed to rejection and depression. Because of sin, the kingdom of Israel became divided. Eventually God moved in judgement against the nation he had called to himself and the nation was taken into exile.

Pastor's Column

A special welcome to Matthew & Dianne Mann, Gemma, Amee and Thomas and their family and friends who have gathered with us this morning as Matthew, Gemma, Amee and Thomas receive God's gift of Baptism. It is a timely reminder for all of us of the promises God makes to us through Baptism.

Today we are looking at **how to deal with the temptations that the devil throws at us**, especially in regard to sex, power, in worship, success and in disaster, as we shall discover from the E 100 Challenge for this week (2 Samuel, 1 and 2 Kings). We know we can rely on God to help us in our temptations because we are his children through Baptism. It has a lot to do with early repentance, prayer, meeting with God, listening to him when you fall into depression and knowing that God will never abandon you. I intend to elaborate on these in the address this morning.

You are invited to a special morning tea with the Mann family and friends to celebrate God's wonderful gift of Baptism after worship this morning.

How are you going with the E 100 Challenge? Last week I put the thought to you that we shouldn't have the break between the Old Testament and the New Testament readings. (One reason we had chosen to have this break is that I will be away for several weeks in that second 10 week segment and wouldn't be able to preach on the themes of the New Testament section.) But perhaps it is not as important to have those New Testaments sections preached on as it was with the Old Testament section- which I am doing at the moment, because we are much more familiar with the New Testament. Also we would have got into the good habit of reading the E100. What do you think? Let me know using the Welcome Sheets.
