

# Visit to Golden Grove of 6 nurses from Goroka Hospital, PNG

From 28th-30th July six nurses from Goroka in the Eastern Highlands Province of PNG will be in Adelaide to attend the LCA Parish Nurse Seminar at St Paul's, Blair Athol on 28th July followed by "An introductory course for Parish/Pastoral Care Nurses and other pastoral carers" to be held at GGLF on 29th & 30th July.

Three of the ladies visited with us in 2008 and three have not been here before.

We are therefore looking for willing people who would like to welcome and host one of these ladies in your home for a few nights or possibly up to a week. At this stage we do not yet know of their arrival and departure dates. Even if you can offer a couple of nights accommodation that would be great. These illustrate an unsurpassed, dedicated intellectual collaboration between Indigenous Australians and Europeans starting 175 years ago. 150 years ago, next March, the two synods resolved to initiate our own Mission.
