Week 12— **The Teachings of Jesus**

Overview

This week's readings explore some of Jesus' teaching. Jesus was like other teachers of the time, sometimes speaking directly and other times using stories to get his message across. A lot of Jesus' teaching was based on the Old Testament—the Bible that his listeners knew and that we have been reading so far in *E100 Bible Reading Challenge*. Jesus' teaching made it clear that he was building on what God had done so far, not beginning again. The Messiah who had been promised in the Old Testament had come. God's unfolding plan had reached a new phase, and brought about a new way of living. It was less about compliance, more about relationship. That new way of living was not just for Jesus' listeners; it's also for those who follow Jesus today.

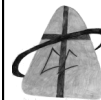
YOUTH NEWS!
