

Welcome to our worship today. A special welcome to the six nurses from **Goroka PNG** who have joined us over these days for the parish nursing course. Also welcome to Pastor Rob and Lynette Wiebusch who are leading this course and welcome to all those who have enrolled in the course and are worshipping with us this morning.

Lynette will be giving us a presentation on parish nursing in the service this morning.

This morning I am taking up the theme from this week's E 100 Challenge: Jesus' miracles by having a look at the Gospel reading for today: John 6:1-21: the feeding of the five thousand. The theme is How do you respond to miracles? This evening in Salt Factory I will take up the theme giving away ministry: encouraging others to use their gifts especially through our congregation.

For your information "The Influencers" (a regional church of Australian Christian Churches/ Paradise AOG) has hired our church plant for their youth ministry. So to make it clear; their ministry, including worship is held at our church/ school plant but not under our auspices.

Next Sunday morning taking up the theme of the E 100 Challenge we will be holding a "choral service" on the theme of Jesus' suffering, death and resurrection for us. Graeme and Daryl will be giving their synod report and we have what I would call a thought stunning, provoking, inspirational video to help us think about our giving to God's work in our congregation.
