In this week's readings we have seen how Jesus was betrayed, tried, and put to death by those who rejected him. But Christ rose from the dead, conquering death forever. After his resurrection he continued to meet with his disciples, challenging their preconceptions and ideas of what it meant to follow him. While the passages we have looked at are primarily historical in nature, there are many practical lessons here that will help us to be followers of God in the 21st century.


