

Overview

This week's readings focus on the birth of the church and its early history, a period of remarkable growth. The Holy Spirit came and enabled the early believers to continue doing the miracles that Jesus himself had done, and had commanded his disciples to do. The Holy Spirit continued to work healings and miracles, but also enabled the early church to form a strong sense of community and to face persecution and opposition with remarkable boldness and faith. The early chapters of Acts contain much to challenge and encourage us.
