

## 25th November 2012—Last Sunday of Church Year

## WELCOME to all worshipping with us today

Greetings to any visitors here with us. We are pleased to have you join us and we trust you have felt welcomed and pray the Holy Spirit may enlighten and empower us with the message shared today.

#### Before Worship ....

The first reading today (**Hebrew 9:11-14**) is one that we didn't have at the beginning of the month (because we celebrated Reformation Day and used those readings) and one in which Graham Pfeffer will be basing his (*first*) sermon (*in a congregation*). He is speaking on the topic of "The Blood that cleanses". I love verse 14 in particular: ... "How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our conscience from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!"

The other readings for the day (the last Sunday of the Church Year) take up the theme of the last things — Jesus coming in all his glory to judge.

In **John 5:21-29** Jesus speaks of his authority to judge. But this is not a threatening message for us who believe in Jesus- "who hears his word" and have "crossed over from death to life." (Verse 24)- we know him as a friend.

So, we can look forward to Jesus coming back, as the second reading (**Revelation 1:4b-8**) describes it: "Look, he is coming with the clouds, and 'Every eyes will see him, even those who pierced him; and all people will because of him'. So shall it be. Amen." (Verse 7)

### Pastor's Column

As I stated in the "Before Worship..." **Graham Pfeffer** is presenting his "first sermon" this morning. Graham received his preaching licence on Friday and we are honoured that he would present it to ushis adopted congregation.

I am sorry that anyone came to worship expecting Holy Communion. As we announced last week with me being away (preaching at my first congregation- Yarraman, Queensland where I served 25 years ago, at their anniversary service) there were no ordained pastors to officiate at Holy Communion- so we had it last week.

Also, as I informed you last Sunday, I have received a call to serve at **Burrumbuttock**. (Burrumbuttock parish is in the Riverina- NSW District, not far from Albury). Please keep me in your prayers as I deliberate over this call.

This evening Luke Napier will be speaking at Salt Factory and Lauren and Geoff Thiel will be making their wonderful "Christian Giving" presentation.

Next Saturday (1<sup>st</sup> December) we are holding a DAY OF REPENT-ANCE.

As I have informed you over the last month- being the last day of the church year we feel it is a good opportunity to come on your own or with others to repent of your own sins and especially the "sins of the community" (I call these "corporate sins": sins that we are guilty of because we belong to a body and in our case it's our congregation.)

You will have some resources for the occasion which will be available from the small chapel on the day. There will be some "prayer requests" that people have submitted. If you have any requests please pass them onto me as soon as possible. We do ask you though, to be sensitive and gracious in what you write. Yet we do encourage you to contribute to the day in this way, especially if God has put on your heart certain corporate sins which we need to present to God in prayer.

A day of repentance- as with any repentance - must have the Absolution. That Absolution will be pronounced at the 10.30am Sunday service.

Remember this Day of Repentance will be centred on the SMALL CHAPEL (the code **C 289 5033**- *Just turn off the light, put out any candles, leave it in the condition you found it and close the door when you leave.*) and THE PRAYER GARDEN (access via the GOSH gate (Code **5127**). Feel free to come any time during the day and stay as long as you like. If an overflow is required, we can use the Fellowship Lounge, Pastor's Church Study and Fellowship Centre as well.

Thanks to the **Women's Fellowship** who have cleaned and tidied the Small Chapel (in preparation for the day)

Also this coming weekend (starting this Thursday is the **Christmas tree Festival at St Johns TTG**.

Also next Weekend.....our **Annual Church/School picnic** (our "family fun day') - 2<sup>nd</sup> December.

PLEASE NOTE Our morning worship will be a little different next Sunday: We begin at 9.30am as normal with a half hour DVD ("Jacob's gift"- suitable for all the family) followed by morning tea (please bring a plate to share" and then as I stated above at 10.30am our R/1 school led family service.
