Before Worship

The Bible readings for <u>23rd December</u> (as listed on last week's "Daily Bible Readings") are <u>Micah 5:2-5a</u>, <u>Hebrews 10:5-10</u>, <u>Luke 1:39-45</u>- (for Advent 4, series B)- wonderful Bible readings. I hope you read them today.

But we are using the Bible readings that the play the "Inn Keeper's surprise" depicts (<u>Luke 2:4-7</u>, 15-20; <u>Matthew 2:10</u>,

11) and one I shall be briefly speaking about (Ephesians 5:13-20) on being asleep and missing out.

On <u>Christmas Day</u> the set Bible readings are <u>Isaiah 62:6-12</u>, <u>Titus 3:4-7 Luke 2:8-20</u>. Again I encourage you to read them. However, on Christmas Day we'll be listening to two passages <u>Matthew 25:34-46</u>, <u>Luke 2:1-20</u> which relate to the sermon I am presenting "Love in weakness".

I love the idea that God became weak (like us) so that we could relate to him (our "hearts could go out to him"). I also love the idea that God's heart goes out to us – in our weakness and this in turn motivates us to love those who are weak (and indeed allows us to see that weakness). This is the essence of my Christmas Day message. I am sure God will touch you through it.

Below is the pray of the prayer of the day for Christmas which we shall be using in our worship.

Prayer: Almighty and merciful God, we thank you for sending your Son to become human like us, so that we might become your children. Make us who trust in Jesus to be more and more like him. For he lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. **Amen.**
