TWO MINUTES

1 Corinthians 1:10 –"I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another in what you say and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly united in mind and thought."

Sometimes we question the decisions of our fellow brothers and sisters in Christ. People in leadership positions in particular are often scrutinised by the choices they make while in power. Most of the time, these people are simply trying to be servants of the Lord. Sometimes, their own personal desires lead them astray. Or sometimes, they can be manipulated by the devil down a path which they believe is right. Many people can have different opinions, which can often cause conflict.

Everyone is unique, and will make different choices and have different opinions, because that is how the Lord has made us. But we should not let these differences pull as apart from one another. Paul instructs us to be a united body of Christ. It is important then, that first and foremost, we look to the Lord for his guidance. Let us have faith that he will show us the best path to take, and give us the strength to follow him.

Prayer: Lord, reveal to us your desires for our lives, and help us to serve you with our lives. Amen.

Thank you James for preaching to us this morning and Ruth for giving your testimony/report/encouragement. **James Leach** is a 4th year ALC student assigned to our congregation and **Ruth Zimmermann** is a lecturer at ALC. Our service this morning will also feature a DVD that gives us an insight into **Australian Lutheran College** ("The Sem.") which is the tertiary educational institution of our church and works with, as we put it *to make Christ known...*: yet another reason to "Thank God for the opportunities he has given us."

Next week we are going to thank God especially for **our School**.
