Pastor's Column

Today we are celebrating our **Harvest Thanksgiving Service**.

You are invited to place the produce you have brought for LCC (non perishables) and to ALC (the rest) on and around the stage as you enter this morning. This is our first expression of worship this morning- an offering to God (through LCC and ALC), a way of laying down who we are (symbolized by what we've brought) at the base of the cross, an offering of gratitude to God for all that he has done and (in faith we can say) all that he will do for us.

Salt Factory commences for the year, tonight with a dinner beforehand. The theme will be the same as this morning: "Don't forget God, based on the first reading - Deuteronomy 8 When you have eaten and are satisfied, praise the LORD your God for the good land he has given you. Be careful that you do not forget the LORD your God ...When we have so much it's one of the easiest things to forget God. We'll look at ways today of ensuring that we don't fall into this trap.

Next week we continue the theme of "Thanking God for the opportunities" and focus on our Golden Grove Amateur Fishing, the following week (20/2/11) our Fellowship Groups with a *Kids at Heart Family* service and baptism, and then (27/2/11) our Journey - at our Confirmation Service, and the following week (6/3/11)our Youth – just before we enter Lent. This will lead into the 40 Days of Purpose, the precursor for the 40 days of Community in September/October 2011.

Advance Notice: **The Gathering** at the Friedrich's, **Saturday 19**th **February (8.30-1pm)**. I would really love to see you there that Saturday morning. We'll be hearing what our Communication's Officer has been up to, discussing the structure of our congregation (How is the congregation led? What do you do if you have a new ministry in mind? How can you get involved?). As well as that there will be a time of worship, fellowship and prayer. Please bring morning tea to share, a chair, a salad, insect repellant and money towards the BBQ lunch (a warning upon arrival to watch where you step: the chickens are free range!) Over the last few months I have used this opportunity in the Bulletin to point out some ways we are keeping/ challenged to keep/ not keeping our goal at Golden Grove Lutheran Fellowship: care, communicate, connect so that people know Christ. Lutheran Community Care is not strictly a part of our Fellowship but it is an agency of our wider church and as we work together through this agency we are fulfilling our goal. (At GGLF we have chosen not to deliver too many welfare ministries as a congregation- although we do have the Meals Ministry and the Class Carers and our Pastoral Carers of course, and a lot of support is given through our Fellowship Groups, so LCC is a God send: a ready made ministry opportunity that we can be involved in.)



Mudmap for directions to Friedrich's house


