TWO MINUTES

How do you identify yourself?

For we are God's co-workers; you are God's field, God's building. (1 Corinthians 3:9)

Often at social events (such as GGAF events) people who are trying to make our acquaintance ask particular questions. What are they?

I have been asked my name, where I come from, what I do for a living, what family I have, what I enjoy doing, what footy team I support...but never how is God involved in my life.

Yet that is precisely the way Paul identifies the Corinthians who he is writing to. They had been boasting about who they follow and what they did and Paul had to make it clear to them -and to us, it's not about you, it's all about God: *So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow. (verse 7)*

It is God at work **with us**, as a co- worker, **in us** since we are God's field and **through us** because we are God's building that not only identifies us but gives us confidence and allows us to give the glory to God.

Just think about what it means to be God's co-worker... God's field... God's building....

It's not as though we have to try to be like this, either. This is what God has made us because we are his. What a wonderful way to identify ourselves. This is something that I will elaborate on in the sermon this morning.

Prayer: *Lord, thank you for the honour of being your co worker, your field and your building. May we be worthy of that honour by allowing you to work with, in and through us. Please forgive us when we have identified ourselves merely by whom we follow or what we do. Amen.*

Today we are thanking God for the opportunities he has given us through our **Golden Grove Amateur Fishing** to make Christ known (the purpose of our existence).

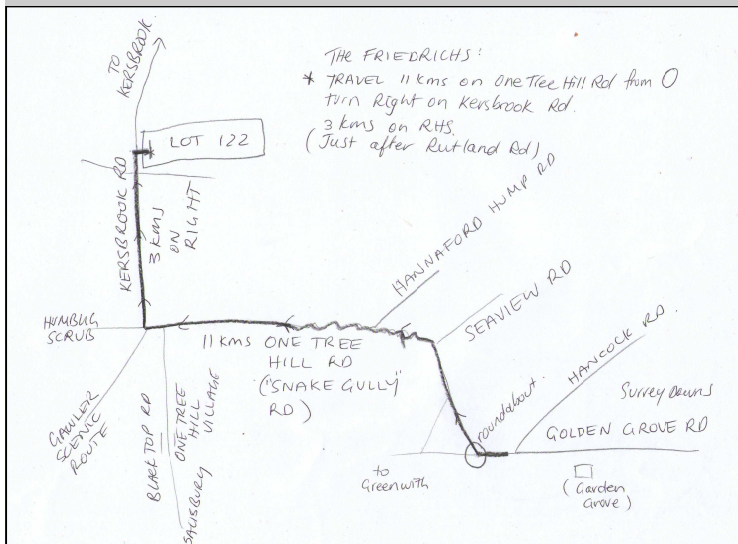
