TWO MINUTES

The readings for today all speak of God demanding holiness in his people.

Leviticus 19:2 reveals God telling Moses to speak to all the congregations of the people of Israel and say to them, "You shall be holy for I the Lord your God am holy". The reading continues with a list of instructions how God wanted this holiness displayed in the lives and conduct of his people.

In the Gospel reading, Jesus is provoking self examination of the heart, how have we handled retaliation? How have we loved our enemies? Jesus said "be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect".

There is no way we can do what is required to obtain salvation. God demands perfection, which we sinners cannot achieve. Our perfection is in Christ alone. As God's redeemed people, Jesus declares our sins are forgiven. Christ has fulfilled the law. We are saved and made holy by <u>grace alone</u> through <u>faith alone</u> in <u>Christ alone</u> read in <u>scripture alone</u>.

Heavenly Father, though I often fall short of your perfection, forgive my sins for Jesus sake and strengthen me for service. Amen

Pastor's Column

Wasn't "The Gathering" yesterday wonderful?

Welcome to **Natasha, Craig, Lucy and Lily Steen** and your family and friends who have gathered for Lily's baptism. What a wonderful day this is: a great day for a miracle!

Today we continue our theme of "Thanking God for the opportunities he has given us to make Christ known" by looking at our **Fellowship Groups**. Thanks to Jon & Leanne Schiller, our Fellowship Group coordinators, and to all those who contributed to this special service this morning.

Do you belong to one of the Fellowship groups in our congregation? I hope today's service encourages you to join or if you do belong, to get more involved.

In the address this morning, based on the second reading (and in particular **1 Corinthians 3:10, 11** *By the grace God has given me, I laid a foundation as a wise builder, and someone else is building on it. But each one should build with care. For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ.*) we consider what is the basis of a "**balanced Fellowship Group**".

This is a "Kid's @ Heart" Service so thanks to the team for your input.

Confirmation: Next Sunday morning 9 young people will be confirming their faith in our congregation: Dylan Dabinett, Isabella DeVizio, Brennan Franklin, Emma Gillard, Tom Haill, Leon & Nathan Pfeffer, Darcy Nitschke and Alex Schutz. I hope you can join us and confirm your own faith in our worship this week.

We are commencing this year's **Step Up to Communion course** on 1st March for year 5s at our school. If you are in year 5 or above, don't go to our school and would like to "step up to communion" I am holding a course at an alternative time on Sunday afternoons at 4.30pm, beginning 6th March. The course is planned for 6 sessions. (For the year 5s: 3 in school and 3 on a Sunday afternoon with parents, and 6 on a Sunday afternoon with parents for those not in year 5 at GGLPS. This class' First Communion is planned for Palm Sunday (17th April).

During Lent this year (starting 9th March) you are encouraged to use **Purpose Driven Life** book as your daily devotion. We are also encouraging the Fellowship Groups to take these devotions up at their meetings (and if possible to meet weekly during this time). If you don't belong to a Fellowship Group and would like to discuss your daily devotions we are holding Wednesday evening sessions, starting on 16th March. (The previous week: 9th March- Ash Wednesday we are holding our Ash Wednesday worship service). (You can also come along to this discussion group even if you do belong to a Fellowship Group of course.) On the Sundays of Lent we will be taking up the **40 Days of Purpose** themes. If you don't have a Purpose Driven Life Book second hand books are available from Pastor.

Please note that I have moved into my **new School Study**. This is in the new administration block. Feel free to visit and I will show you around our new building. Unfortunately this distances me a little further from the church plant. So to make myself (and my books that you can borrow) more accessible, I now have a **Church Study** too (Paul's former room - he is now where James and prior to that Anna had their office and where Pastor Alex had his office). This space is also available for small meetings too (it holds about 8 people), if I am not using it. When you make an appointment to see me – let me know if it's to be in my "School Study" or "Church Study". Most mornings you will still find me in my School Study.

Fellowship Groups are the heart of **our goal** at Golden Grove Lutheran Fellowship: care, communicate, connect so that people know Christ. Some of the best caring, communicating and connecting happen in the context of Fellowship Groups. It's where you can ask questions, be cared for and together care for others and, working as a team, get involved in an aspect of GGLF which you haven't had much to do with before.

But Fellowship Groups can also be a means of just the opposite. Do you know what I mean? People can gossip and criticize in Fellowship Groups, people can feel very lonely and left out in Fellowship Groups and people can become very cliquey in Fellowship Groups. Fellowship Groups are a powerful means for both blessings and curses. Use them well. **Pastor Leon**
