TWO MINUTES

Readings: Exodus 24:12-18, 2 Peter 1:16-21 and Matt 17:1-9

In each of these readings God the Father is speaking. In Exodus God is talking to Moses to come up the mountain so He can give him tablets of stone for the teaching of his people. In 2 Peter it mentions God speaking at Jesus baptism – 'This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased.' Then in Matt 17 God speaks again 'This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. Listen to Him.'

So we are instructed by God to listen and obey. Are we taking the time to first read and understand His word and then secondly, to put it into action?

So what does God and Jesus teach us – basically it comes down to these commands: to love God with ALL your heart, soul, strength & mind and to love your neighbour as yourself (ie be His witness here on earth). But how? We cannot do it by ourself. Jesus left this earth so we could receive the power of the Holy Spirit, so we are strengthened with His power and in our relationship with God.

If you have not received or need the renewing power of the Holy Spirit, ask God for it. Ask someone who is willing to pray for you (eg Pastor Leon or myself) to receive the power of the Holy Spirit. Then pray and step out in faith to share God's saving grace with people that you connect with.

As our Values puts it: "with their enthusiasm, initiative and boldness". I hope this service – and sermon- is a little radical, considering that we are looking at our Youth. To this end we are planning to have a "Salt Factory style service" in the morning worship time slot! I pray that you may enjoy it, be stirred up by it and appreciate once more the many blessings God is giving us at GGLF.

The address is based on our new (confirmation) banners. For your consideration I have printed out the message:

**On the day I was confirmed
The joy of believing filled my heart
The blessing of belonging filled my thoughts
The promise of god's love filled my Spirit
The Light of God's Word filled my soul
And the precious gift of knowing I am and he is mine

I hope you are planning to join us for our Ash Wednesday worship this week.

During Lent this year we are using **Purpose Driven Life book as our daily devotion**. We are also encouraging the Fellowship Groups to take up these devotions at their meetings (and if possible to meet weekly during his time). If you don't belong to a Fellowship Group and would like to discuss your daily devotions we are holding Wednesday evening sessions, starting Wednesday week 16th March. (You can also come along to this discussion group even if you do belong to a Fellowship Group of course.) On the Sundays of Lent we will be taking up the 40 Days of Purpose themes. *If you don't have a Purpose Driven Life Book second hand books are available from Pastor.*

Next Sunday we are taking up the Purpose Driven Life Theme: **What on earth am I here for?**

We are commencing this year's **Step Up to Communion course** this afternoon at 4.30pm. If you know of anyone who is could be a candidate for this course, please let them know. This classes' First Communion is planned for Palm Sunday (17th April).

Another way you show **our Fellowship's goal of Care, communicate, connect to know Christ** is by supporting the youth. How can you care, communicate and connect with the youth? One simple way is taking the opportunity to talk to a young person after our morning worship or Salt Factory or during our Salt Factory dinner. You could help out at Rev320 (after you've done the Safe Place thing) with transport etc. There are projects that you will be hearing more about from the Youth such as TOM shoes which you could support as well. Why not talk to our YLT, Paul and find out what the Youth are doing and discover how YOU can care, communicate and connect in this ministry.


