St Paul also reminds us of God's purpose for each of us in that while we were still sinners His son, Jesus died for us so that we could be put right with Him. In birth we were created to be God's family and through baptism we are born again and become part of His family. There is hope for all because of what God has done through his Son, hope for everyone, for that Samaritan women of dubious past and for me and you too!
