TWO MINUTES

John 9

⁴ As long as it is day, we must do the works of him who sent me. Night is coming, when no one can work. ⁵ While I am in the world, I am the light of the world."

In this chapter, Jesus uses the healing of physical blindness to explain the concept of spiritual blindness. At tonight's Salt Factory service, we will explore this chapter further. Not only do we need to understand whether we are blind, but furthermore how this affects our ability to serve the Lord, that is, to fulfil our purpose.

²⁵ He replied, "Whether he is a sinner or not, I don't know. One thing I do know. I was blind but now I see!" Notice the last few words in verse 25 – you'll also find them in the first verse of Amazing Grace. Before we can receive God's grace and forgiveness, we must acknowledge that we are sinners. It is sin that keeps us in the darkness; that keeps us blind.

All praise to God the Father, who sent his Son to die on the cross, so that our eyes are opened and we are set free.

Prayer: Lord, open our eyes to your purpose for us and help us to be your servants. Amen.

Pastor's Column

Our next installment this morning of the **Purpose Driven Life** is: "You were created to become like Christ." (Purpose 3) This is based on Philippians 2:5 "Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus". Have you ever thought what is the purpose of all that I have to go through in life; the troubles, the temptations, the trespasses of life? What type of person does God want me to become? How can I use those things that life throws at me to become that person God has planned for me to be. This morning's address will answer these queries and more.

Are you still studying the **Purpose Driven Life** book? Sometimes I struggle to keep up my reading - it's another resource that I added to devotional life and I too find it hard to fit it all in. But Rick Warren gives some great insights doesn't he? I encourage you to take it up again if you have forgotten about it (you don't have to read the chapter you missed- although it's to your detriment not to. If you are trying to keep up with the rest of the Fellowship, we are up to chapter 22 today.) Don't forget our discussion group each Wednesday at **7pm**.

Today Natalie Bubner from the **HANDS group** (who ride to raise money for East Timor) will give a presentation at both services on their Health and Education projects in Timor .

Also after worship this morning we are holding a **meeting at 11am** for those interested in our **music ministry** to consider our whole approach to music in our worship services.

You will notice in the list of meetings below that we have a **Step Up to Communion course** running at the moment. There are 11 young people preparing for their **First Communion**. For many of those it will be in two week's time (Palm Sunday) at the Salt Factory worship.
