### **TWO MINUTES**

# Pastor's Column

Why has God made you the person you are/ formed you into the SHAPE that you are/ given you gifts? This morning in the 4<sup>th</sup> Purpose of **Purpose Driven Life**, we'll discover the answer is to serve others. So what does it mean to serve people? How can we better serve them? What motivates us to serve? I reckon we'll get the answers to these questions this morning in our address. The text for today is **1 Peter 4:10** "Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others".

Are you still studying the **Purpose Driven Life** book? Last week I heard of someone who had just discovered it! ...and was thrilled at what God was saying to them. It's not too late to start the book. If you are trying to keep up with the rest of the Fellowship, we are up to chapter 28 today. Don't forget our discussion group each Wednesday at 7pm.

You will notice in the list of meetings (below) that we have a **Step Up to Communion course** running at the moment. Actually, the last session is being held today. This last session is entitled: "*Are you serious?*" and in this session I will individually ask the 12 young people who are doing this course: Do you believe that Holy Communion is the body and blood of Jesus Christ? Do you intend to partake of Holy Communion regularly? Parents, are you going to support your young person in receiving Holy Communicant member of Golden Grove Lutheran Fellowship. The **First Communion** for many of them will be **next Sunday (Palm Sunday)** at the Salt Factory worship.

The **Journey** (confirmation) course started this week. *Advance Notice:* We are planning for the day of confirmation 19<sup>th</sup> February 2012. This course will include the after school sessions, Sunday afternoon sessions and 3 camps.
