

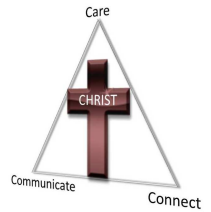

Pastor's Column

Palm Sunday is always a highlight in the year. The first day of holy week, with the count down to Easter (and the end of our Lenten disciplines) and for us at GGLF this year the end of our 40 Days of Purpose. (Today is day 36 and we are looking at the last of the Purposes, the 5th: "You were made for a mission").

The last of our 40 Days of Purpose discussion groups is being held this Wednesday night which will include these chapters of the Purpose Driven Life.

Today expect a few miracles: a couple of baptisms: **Lailani and Asha Raikiwasa** in the morning service and a number of young people are having their **first communion** in the evening's Salt Factory worship.

13 young people completed the Step Up to Communion course over 6 sessions and have been invited to become communicant members of the LCA. The 11 young people who are receiving their first communion this evening are: **Eden Bishop, Jack and Max Hail, Brayden Hogben, Phoebe Jachmann-Evans, Dahlia Kluynk, Lachlan Koch, Brody McLuckie, Amelia Regnier-Leach, Tye Schiller, Elijah Schutz.** (**Belinda Heinrich & Chantelle Heuston** have opted to have their first communion in a few weeks time.)

The theme of this evening's worship is **Holy Communion** and we are having a closer look at Holy Communion in Corinth from 1 Corinthians 11.

Even though there is no Salt Factory Dinner tonight (because it is school holidays), the families of the young people who are receiving their first communion today have chosen to have **a meal together**. If you would like to join us please bring along a plate of dinner to share.

Also this morning we are having a blessing upon the container that we packed to go to Asaroka

I regret that we no longer have a paid **Youth Team Leader**. Paul Swansson's contract has not been renewed. (See the notice elsewhere in this Bulletin.) We are celebrating his role as our YLT over the last 2 years in this morning's service with a special morning tea for him and his family after this morning's worship. I hope you can stay for this.

We have held meetings over the last 2 Fridays with the youth and their parents (at a Bakery event and a Rev320 event) to ascertain how our youth ministry will continue in the future and I believe a steering committee will be set up to investigate our future paid staff situation at GGLF.

On the evening/morning we shall be learning about Jesus' final hours before his death and will learn more about Easter through discussion, bible study and meditation.

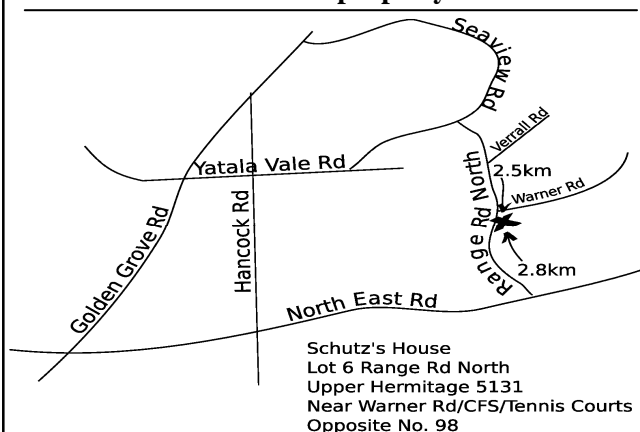
