A blessed Easter to you. What a wonderful time to worship and I am hoping that you are making the most of the opportunity that the worship team, bands and those rostered at Golden Grove Lutheran Fellowship are providing for you.

Maundy Thursday features Holy Communion as well as the foot washing. The theme of the address is "Servant leadership".

I hope that some of the **Stations of the Cross** that were used for the "Night to Remember" which the young people experienced after the Maundy Thursday service will be available for your meditation before the Good Friday service. Why don't you come a little earlier to church so that you can utilize these?

Good Friday this year also includes Holy Communion and the sights and sounds, smells and sensations of that first Good Friday. The service is based on the gospel reading for Good Friday (John 18, 19). A focal point for the service is the veil in front of the Altar.

Easter dawn service is at the Schutz's (see mud map) at 6am based around 1 Corinthians 15. It is entitled "A Resurrection Celebration" and features the Hallelujah Chorus. Hot Cross bun breakfast will be provided after the worship.

The **9.30am Main Easter Service** will be preceded by an 8.45am hot cross bun breakfast. **Eliora Grace Leach** will be baptized and ALC student James Leach will be preaching.

There won't be a Salt Factory worship service on Easter Sunday.

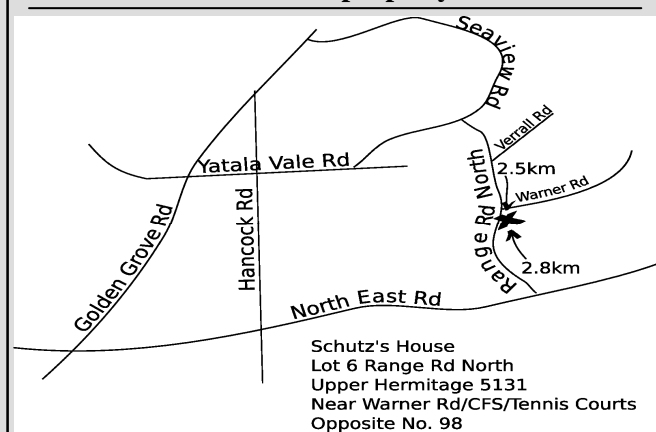
I hope that you can join us for all of these worship experiences.

What a great and memorable moment it was last Sunday after service when as a congregation we went out and the people all laid their hands on the container while Pastor Leon performed a blessing of it. There were people all the way around it. It was

picked up on Monday and I understand it should be loaded before Easter to begin about a 6 week journey to Lae in PNG.

We thank and praise God for all the miracles he has performed to bring this to fruition. We sincerely thank everyone who has contributed in any way, and there have been many, including those donating money to help cover freight costs. The word is that the whole community around Asaroka are extremely excited about the project and what benefit this will bring to their own and other kids through the schools.

Very special thanks must go to the outside sponsors: Rotary – Donations In Kind, South Pacific Aid Inc, IT Share, Rotary Tea Tree Gully and Paul Stevens. Without their help we couldn't have achieved what we have.

The following is a broad summary of sorts of what has been sent:

- 5 Pallets of text books and library books and about 90 other boxes of various books.
- 120 Computers (total) with some printers, fax & other bits
- Large Photocopier, 2 Typewriters, 5 Sewing Machines & spares
- 4 Televisions with DVD/Video players and cabinets for class room use
- Pallet A4 paper, many various boxes of resources & craft items
- Desks for approx 280 students and 300 chairs for students
- Various medical equipment and resources for the medical centre
- Business phone system for the schools for intercom use
- Teachers desks, chairs, cabinets, pin-up boards, display walls
- Various student uniforms & hats, sports equipment
- 1 Piano & 2 Electric Keyboards, 2 Fridges, 2 Filing Cabinets
- ◆ Other various bits & pieces

I keep reminding people that these are the sorts of things that were on the schools 'Wish Lists', which makes this more special. Please keep the Container in your prayers for safe passage and a quick clearance through Lae Customs when it arrives.
