This morning the theme for our worship is "**Put your trust in Jesus.**" Based on John 14:1 Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God; trust also in me", which is part of our Gospel reading for today. We shall be looking at how Jesus gets attention, how he comforts us and how this trusting in him deepens our faith in God.

This morning 3 young people will be having their **First Communion. Belinda Heinrich, Chantelle Heuston** and **Dahlia Klunyk** did the Step Up to Communion course with the rest of the class during Lent but were not able to have their first communion on Palm Sunday and have opted to have it today. We pray that God will bless them and us as they are admitted to communion...

This evening we shall be hearing from **Bevan Schubert.** He will be speaking on "**What's God's purpose for your life**?" based on Matthew 16:24-25. "*Then Jesus said to his disciples, "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. For whoever wants to save his life, will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will find it*". From what I understand his presentation will be something very different (quite out of the box) I believe you will certainly remember it.

This morning we are also having our School and Congregation's **Annual General Meetings**. I hope you can all stay for this. A couple of major issues are the proposed new structure for our Fellowship and the heating and cooling for our worship centre.

The group that met to discuss "**the 40 Days of Community**" have decided to postpone running the program until this time next year. But in the meantime we are encouraging the leaders of the congregation to join in studying "**Better together**" the participants' book for the 40 Days of Community. We expect that this will overflow into a flood of enthusiasm for the program.

Salt Factory will be a School family Service run by the 4/5 cluster. The theme is worship. I assure you from what the teachers have planned it will be lively, inspiring and informative.
