

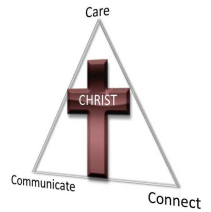

Pastor's Column

Welcome to this **Pentecost worship service.**

The theme for the address this morning, based on the Gospel reading for today John 20:19-23 is "How do you get peace?" As you might guess it is from the Holy Spirit. But how does the Holy Spirit give it to us. I will give you a clue: it does have something to do with what we do!

On this Queen's Birthday **long weekend** I am sure that those who are away this weekend, including those on the River Murray Fishing Trip are thinking of us.

Don't forget about the special Pentecost service at St Mark's Anglican Church (The Golden Way) at 6pm, which is focusing on the work we are doing in schools through our Christian Pastoral Support Workers. It will incorporate the **commissioning of our 4 newest CPSWs** in our TTG area. I shall be leading that rite of commissioning but of course Salt Factory is also being held tonight too (even though there isn't a dinner preceding it) and the theme of that service is Pentecost as well.

This morning Francis Boyle one of our **Mainly Music** leaders will be leading the children's address, which will give us an insight into Mainly Music- our ministry to preschoolers on a Tuesday morning. By the way, we have just won a grant from the TTG council for \$2,500 for Mainly Music!

Also this morning we are installing our latest **Pastoral Carer**: elected at our recent AGM: Christiaan Hersevoort. Do you know who are Pastoral Carers are and what they do? We have Judith Whaites, Elnora Schmocker, Marty Seidel, Len & Claire Tscharke, Ken Campbell, Dave & Liz Shrowder. And what do they do. In the rite of blessing this morning I shall say: *Our wish is that all the members of GGLF will continue to care for each other, especially through our Fellowship groups. But the Pastoral Carers have taken on the responsibility to care for people who are not already being cared for; being available to care at worship and fellowship events, endeavouring to integrate, disciple and challenge members and to care for people who drop into the congregation, and to encourage an atmosphere of care and inclusion in our congregation. They run the Ministry of Care meetings towards this end.*

I mentioned last week that over the next few months we shall be studying the book "*Better together*" - the participants' guide for the 40 Days of Community to build up some momentum to the **40 Day of Community** that we plan to run in May/ June of next year.
