Pastor's Column

Today is traditionally called **Trinity Sunday**. It is the only festival of the church year that celebrates a doctrine of the Church: the Holy Trinity. But this revelation of God as three persons in one God is an opportunity to praise God, to confess Him (united we declare what we believe who God is) and to defend him (even though He hardly needs us to do that).

We are going to have a closer look at the Gospel reading (Matthew 28:16-20) **this morning**, the so called "Great Commission", in particular that command of Jesus to "**Make disciples**". Just what is a disciple and how can we make one. We'll look at how Jesus' made disciples, in particular just how we start that close relationship and the very reason we have that revelation of God that I mentioned above.

This evening at Salt Factory we shall be having a closer look at the first reading for today- Genesis 1 to get an insight into God.

This morning we also **install the Board** of Ministry and Management who were elected at our Annual General Meeting, 4 weeks ago. Again that rite uses the name of the Triune God as well.
