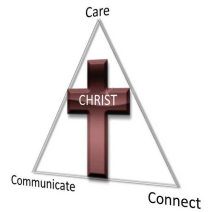

TWO MINUTES

Deep down rest.

²⁸ "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. **Matthew 11:28**

Jesus invites us to come to him for rest. So what is this deep down rest/ this inner peace/ this relief, this joy, this assurance that it's all right which he is offering?.

This deep down rest is:

- ◆ the forgiveness of your sins. So often we try to make amends for what we have done by working instead of resting. Learn that you don't need to do that. Accept that you are forgiven. Yes, give your sins to Jesus, repent, determine not to do that sin again and then leave them with him.
- ◆ the assurance of God's love. Jesus came to the earth to show us who God is/ what love is really like, to assure us that Jesus is approachable- so close to us. Learn that God *is* love. So often we get caught up in a view of God as being the strict judge who is against us.
- ◆ what Jesus has promised us - the Holy Spirit. He won't leave us on our own. He gives us the Holy Spirit who will work through us. So often we try to work things out ourselves. Learn that you have faith, that you are indeed growing in love and that he gives you hope and in fact all the fruit of the Spirit. Jesus draws them out of us as we grow through his Word and Sacrament.

We get this when we come to Jesus. Jesus offers this to you this morning in worship. Come to him take it, receive what he is offering you, appreciate it, thank him for it and live in this deep down rest.

Prayer: Lord we do thank you for your offer to come to you. Lord Jesus we come. Please fill us again with this deep down rest. We need it so much. Amen.
