Matthew 14: 13-21 Jesus feeds the five thousand

Jesus said to his disciples "They do not need to go away. You give them something to eat"

How often have we read and/or heard the parable of the 'loaves and fishes'. I never tire of it. It is indeed only one of the many miracles, brought about by prayer, demonstrating God's mercy and love for his children.

If we read a little closer Vs21 clarifies the parable a little further.
