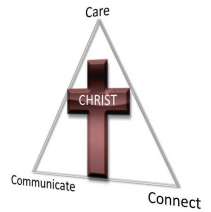

A special welcome to Pastor Peter Steicke who will be leading the service this morning and preaching on the topic of Renewal, based on Isaiah 40:31a. ...but those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. I reckon today's services as the high point of our series "On the wings of an eagle".

May you certainly be refreshed, recharged, restored, revived as well as renewed by God through our September worship. Yes, may the words of the song- our theme song for the month: "Come live in me, all my life take over, come breath in me and I will rise on eagles' wings" (which is on our banner) be your prayer throughout this month and... throughout your life.
